APPROVAL OF THE AMENDED ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME (EMPr) FOR THE PROPOSED DIPPENAAR BOARDWALK ON PORTION 111 OF FARM BRAKKLOOF 443 AND A PORTION OF ERF 2132, PLETTENBERG BAY

1. The abovementioned document dated August 2017 and received by the Directorate: Development Management Region 3 (hereinafter referred to as "this Directorate") on 18 August 2017, refers.
2. By virtue of the powers conferred on it by the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended, the competent authority herewith **approves** the abovementioned amended environmental management programme (EMPr).
3. The information provided to this Directorate regarding the previous correspondence related to compliance with the Environmental Authorisation ("EA") (issued on 26 November 2012), and the recent fires and disaster events in the region are noted.

Please note that in terms of Section 49A of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) ("NEMA"), a person is guilty of an offence if that person fails to comply with or contravenes a condition of an environmental authorisation granted for a listed activity or an approved environmental management programme.

Any non-compliance with a condition of the Environmental Authorisation or the approved EMPr may render the holder liable for criminal prosecution.

You are urged to comply with the conditions of approval in the EA and the approved EMPr.

4. Prior to commencing with the physical implementation of the activities, you are respectfully reminded to ensure full compliance with all the relevant conditions of approval, *inter alia*:

Proof must be submitted to the Competent Authority (this Directorate) of the following:

(a) **Condition 4:** Proof that the registered interested and affected parties (I&APs) have been notified of EA that was issued and their right to an appeal.

(b) **Condition 5:** Seven calendar days' notice, in writing, before commencement of construction activities.

Note: Please be advised that the Environmental Authorisation is only valid until 26 November 2017. Should you wish to extend said validity period, an application to amend said EA must be submitted to the Competent Authority prior to the validity period lapsing.

(c) **Condition 10:** Written confirmation that an ECO has been appointed.

3. Kindly quote the abovementioned reference number in any future correspondence in respect of the above Environmental Authorisation.
4. The Department reserves the right to revise initial comments and request further information from you based on any new or revised information received.
