Thank you for your comments.

I do understand your concerns. The area has been assessed by the aquatic specialist and various engineers. The dam design (which is prepared by the engineers to ensure compliance to the specialists' requirements and recommendations), allows for it to be developed in two phases; this will ensure compliance of the applicant to the first storage phase and then move on to construct the second phase. Monitoring of water quantities will be automated and will be sent to the Department monthly to maintain compliance and allow for the second phase to commence. Sufficient water is planned to be released to ensure downstream users are not impacted by the proposed dam.

Kindly refer to the attached method statement for dam construction and the EMPr. If approval is given these will become legally binding documents.
